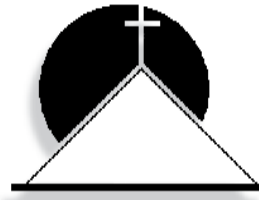

Holding God And His Name In Reverence & Honor

Principles Relevant Today...

- There's a throne in each human heart - Who or what sits there
- Who and how we are to worship - Idolatry has always been forbidden
- We are to reverence even the name of God – Hallowed be Thy Name
- The Lesson in miniature – It has more to do with the heart than the tongue

Reading Our Text From Several Translations...

What's Forbidden By This Principle – Do Not Take God's Name In Vain...

- Not taking His Name in vain within our heart
- Not taking His Name in vain with the tongue - Not Blaspheming...
 - By cursing
 - By using His Name as an expletive
 - We must not use His Name as a cliché
 - By false or trivial oaths
- We must not use God's Name in vain by the way we live - Hypocritically

Ways We Can Honor – Hallow – Reverence His Name...

- By exalting His Name
- By glorifying Him
- By approaching His throne with reverence
- By acknowledging we are saved by no other Name
- By understanding that one day all will honor His Name

Our Invitation

- 1 And God spoke all these words:
- 2 "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.
- 3 "You shall have no other gods before me.
- 4 "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.
- 5 You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,
- 6 but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.
- 7 **"You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.**
- 8 "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
- 9 Six days you shall labour and do all your work,
- 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.
- 11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.
- 12 "Honour your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.
- 13 "You shall not murder.
- 14 "You shall not commit adultery.
- 15 "You shall not steal.
- 16 "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
- 17 "You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
